* Composite Levies – This fee includes costs for the College Diary, College Newsletter, Combination Lock (Yr 7), ID card, Sick Bay, annual Chronicle, SRC fees, Special events, Library and Audio-Visual fees, Shuttle and camp buses, stationary/materials of all learning areas, College printed subject booklets, photocopying of subject materials, compulsory subject excursions and outdoor education.
Capital Fee – This fee assists in maintaining student printing, downloads and IT infrastructure. The total annual school fees for the 2009 school year are charged at the end of September 2008.

PAYMENT OF FEES & CHARGES

School fees should be paid in four instalments during the school year:

Families who prefer to pay in smaller instalments **weekly, fortnightly** or **monthly** are encouraged to use the Direct Debit system. Direct Debt forms are available from the Accounts Office.

Fee payments by BPAY, EFTPOS or by credit cards (*MasterCard, VISA or Bankcard*) are accepted.

Families who receive **CENTRELINK FAMILY PAYMENTS** may choose to pay school fees as fortnightly deduction from their **Centrelink payment**. Forms are available at the Accounts Office to avail of this option.

SCHOOL BUILDING FUND

Each family is requested to contribute to the School Building Fund. This is a voluntary contribution and is tax deductible. For **2009** school year we suggest the amount of **\$350**. This fund is used for capital expenditures: building improvements and refurbishment and capital acquisitions.

Donations of **\$500** or more will be acknowledged in an Honour Board.

Every year in mid June Year 8 students that have met set criteria sit a Scholarship examination.
