* Composite Levies – This fee includes costs for the College Newsletter, Combination Lock (Yr 7), ID card, Sick Bay, annual Chronicle, SRC fees, Special events, Library and Audio-Visual fees, Shuttle and camp buses, stationary / materials of all learning areas, Class sets, photocopying of subject materials and exams, compulsory subject excursions, outdoor education camps, Directions 9 Programme, Learner-Mentor Programs, Seminar Days, Year 12 Retreats.

Capital Fee – This fee assists in maintaining student printing, downloads and ICT infrastructure. This includes a notebook levy approved by the Board of Management in 2013 to partly cover the cost of notebook given in Year 7 and Year 10, so that students can keep their assigned notebooks at the end of three years.

The total annual school fees for the 2019 school year are charged at the end of September 2018.

FEE DEPOSIT FOR NEW STUDENTS

A deposit of \$500 is to be paid upon acceptance of an enrolment place for incoming new students. This normally is due in May of the enrolment year. This deposit will be deducted from the total fees payable for the succeeding year.

FAMILY DISCOUNTS

Discounts on tuition fees only, are available for those families with more than one student attending either Caroline Chisholm Catholic College or Marian College. Discounts are as follows:

- 2 students – 10%
- 3 students – 20%
- 4 students – 40%

PAYMENT OF FEES & CHARGES

School fees should be paid in four instalments during the school year:

First Instalment	18 October 2018
Second Instalment	14 March 2019
Third Instalment	16 May 2019
Fourth Instalment	18 July 2019

FEE DISCOUNTS

A 5% discount on tuition fees and composite levies will be granted if **total fees** for the year are paid by the 2nd instalment date by **14 March 2019**.

SCHOOL FEES PAYMENT PLAN

Families who prefer to pay in smaller instalments **weekly, fortnightly** or **monthly** are encouraged to use the Direct Debit system. Direct Debt forms are available from the Accounts Office. Fee payments by BPAY, EFTPOS or by credit cards (*MasterCard, VISA or Bankcard*) are accepted.

Families who receive **Centrelink Family Payments** may choose to pay school fees as fortnightly deduction from their Centrelink payment. Forms are available from the Accounts Office.

SCHOOL BUILDING FUND

Each family is requested to contribute to the School Building Fund. This is a voluntary contribution and is tax deductible. For **2019** school year we suggest the amount of **\$4,000**. This fund is used for capital expenditures: building improvements and refurbishment and capital acquisitions.

Donations of **\$5,000** or more will be acknowledged in an Honour Board.

VOLUNTARY COSTS

The College provides a variety of non-compulsory co-curricula activities and social events. Additional costs will be incurred for these activities should parents chose to allow their child to participate. These could include Exchange Programmes, Formal Socials, Senior camps, instrumental music lessons.

Please be made aware that payment of school fees takes precedence over any co-curricula activities and students are deterred from taking part in these school activities unless school fees are paid in full. Please refer to the College's ***Fee Charging & Collection Policy and Procedures***.

Students who wish to apply for a scholarship place must sit an exam that is administered and evaluated by an external body.
